



## OUR VISION

A world without breast cancer. To fulfill our vision, Susan G. Komen® has invested over **\$2.2 billion** in research and community programs around the world, making the organization the largest source of nonprofit funding dedicated to the fight against breast cancer.

## OUR STORY

Since its founding in 1997, Susan G. Komen North Carolina Triangle to the Coast has strived to provide breast health and breast cancer services to all in the region. The Komen Triangle Race for the Cure® has grown over its 18 years to become one of the largest foot races in the Carolinas. In the 2014 Triangle Race, more than **10,000** participants raised over **\$1 million**.

In 2012, the Affiliate added nine additional counties in southeastern North Carolina, offering breast health services at a level that the region has not received before. As a result, Komen North Carolina Triangle to the Coast held the inaugural Komen Wilmington Race for the Cure® on March 2, 2013. The 2014 Wilmington Race attracted 1,300 participants and raised more than **\$200,000**.

## COMMUNITY FOCUSED

**Seventy-five percent** of the net funds raised are invested into our local community. This year, our Affilliate gave more than **\$738,000**. The funds are being used to provide life-saving education, screening, treatment and post treatment services in our 29 county service area. These grants add to a legacy of more than **\$14 million** invested in local organizations since 1997.

- 52,000 Served through outreach and breast health services.
- 7,000 Patient services that includes mammograms, diagnostic services, and clinical breast exams.

## DEDICATED TO RESEARCH

**Twenty-five percent** of the net funds raised support cutting edge research at the national level. A Komen Grant has touched every major breast cancer breakthrough in the past 29 years.

Local researchers have received **122** research grants totaling more than \$30 million since 1982. In 2014, our Affiliate contributed \$291,000 to national research. Our community saw **\$3.6 million** in grants awarded locally to doctors and researchers at Duke and UNC.
